We do want you to understand that we advocate for our children and by no means is this a personal attack on you, but we do want our parental authority to be respected in this partnership in education.

With that being said:

As the Parent(s) of _____, in the _____ grade, we want to have an understanding.

- My/Our child is a Male / Female.
- My/Our child uses the gender appropriate pronouns: He/Him // She/Her.
- I/We decide the clothing that our child wears for the school day, should an accident soil the clothing or a change of clothing be necessary, please contact me/us so that a change of clothing can be provided or approved.
- At no point do I/we approve of “gender studies”, “gender transition discussions” or anything that would be mistaken for suggesting, educating or urging our child to assume or consider a different gender.
- If there are any concerns about “gender”, those conversations should be had with the parent(s) and not in the classroom. I/We will then discuss those with my/our child.

Medical and Social

- I/We require notification as soon as possible of any injury or situation where my/our child should need medical attention. This is for emergencies where prior notification cannot be made.
- I/We do not consent to any of the following: group counseling sessions, individual counseling sessions, gender exploration sessions - with any social worker or councilor unless signed consent for treatment is obtained by the my/us, the parents.

Authority

I/We, the parent(s), will not relinquish my/our authority where it comes to my/our child. If there is a disagreement with the teacher, we reserve the right to consult the Principal. If remedy cannot be made at the school level, I/we reserve the right to take the issue to the Superintendent of Schools. Should that not remedy the situation, I/We reserve the right to take the issue to the School Board and eventually the State School Board, my/our attorney and to use my/our freedom of speech.

We notify you to make certain that we prove to you that we are involved as a partner in education and will be active in my/our child’s school.
